



Welcome to the Townsend Flowage

We hope you enjoy your time on the Townsend Flowage. We'd like to remind you of some regulations that are intended to make your time with us enjoyable, safe and to protect our shoreline.

First, we ask that you abide by the "Slow, No-Wake" rules where posted. The No-Wake areas are designated by buoys and include **all of McCaslin Brook**. This includes the water from the Red Maple Lane boat launch to the main part of the lake. Also, please obey No-Wake in the **bay by the dam and the channel under the bridge between the upper and lower basins**. It's also important to remember that State laws prohibit boats speed in excess of No-Wake within 100 feet of any dock or shoreline. On average, 100 feet is about five to six boat lengths. No-Wake in these areas will help protect our shoreline from costly erosion issue.

Slow, No-Wake is also mandatory before 10:00 AM and after 5:00 PM on all of the Townsend Flowage.

Please help us protect our water from aquatic invasive species including plants and aquatic life. Please follow these **Clean Boat–Clean Water** steps:

- INSPECT your boat, trailer and equipment.
- REMOVE any attached aquatic plants or animals (before launching, after loading and before transporting on a public highway).
- DRAIN all water from boats, motors and all equipment.
- NEVER MOVE live fish away from a waterbody.
- DISPOSE of unwanted bait on shore.
